
Project Zero in action:

White Oak

- Straight grained with a medium to coarse texture
- Strong and durable
- Light to medium brown



Ash

- Light creamy colour with some light brown tones
- Grain pattern similar to oak
- Durable but lightweight



Douglas Fir

- Light brown with a hint of red
- Distinctive grain pattern
- One of the denser softwoods



Walnut

- Rich dark brown colour with some lighter tones
- Straight or wavy grain
- Durable and classic


